Active history --- at a glance

- Engages the student with real people and their responses to real events of their day
- * Brings history alive with details that otherwise have been lost in the trail of didactic history textbooks that "tell" and do not "show" what history was like
- Shows how different people respond in different ways to the same historic challenges
- Explores social, economic, political and personal viewpoints of real people
- Examines contemporaneous writings both public, such as newspapers and articles, and private, such as diaries, journals and letters
- Participates in human emotions and values of the past.
- Uses many sources of first-hand information from which to draw conclusions.
- * Expands the student's scope of interpretations of events as the beliefs, experiences, and actions of contemporaneous persons are revealed in the context of historic events.
